Many thanks for you're interest in Callie and Sprout's potential pups. The pups are due to be born between the 11th to 13h of February 2026.

This litter has a good sound pedigree which contain some very well renowned UK lines. They are sired by Sprout (Archemere Estrella of Mumuland) Who is a stunning red fawn brindle male who has an excellent show line pedigree and has some of the the top international lines as well as UK dogs in his pedigree and is the most gentle and sensitive soul you could wish to meet and Callie Mumuland's Calfuray De Mumu) who we bred from our second foundation girl - Heidi (Archetype Beautiful Breeze Through Mumuland) who is a striking looking black and White girl, who mainly descends from show lines and has a gentle, sound and loving temperament. Callie is from Heidi's very first litter back in June 2020. This is Callie's third and final litter as we only ever breed our girls every two years starting at around 2 years of age, and only ever have a maximum of three litters (provided they don't need a c-section or have other complications from a litter). Callie is a gentle and graceful girl, calm and sensible in nature although like most whippets has her very particular likes and dislikes, she is extremely fond of meeting new people and loves everyone.

Sprout - Is an amazingly well put together boy, with excellent movement and confirmation, he is the complete package with a temperament to match his good looks, very loving and extremely intelligent and being super sensitive to those around him, be it canine or human. Sprout has mainly show based lines his prey drive isn't so high that it is difficult to live with while still ensuring that they remain true to type. However we are extremely careful about this as most of our pups are in pet homes and therefore we are careful about the lines we choose to ensure that our pups are true to breed type in character but not so much so they unable to be let off lead with training or enjoy a peaceful and uneventful walk with

their family. Sprout doesn't live with us and resides in Worksop with a friend of ours. Yvette takes excellent care of him and her other dogs and Sprout just loves being able to sleep in her bed and be pampered. Sprout and Callie compliment each other very well. This is a repeat of the same pairing that we did for Callie's first litter (Whippet F Litter) born September 2022. Which we were so pleased with the resulting pups, we have decided to repeat it for Callie's final litter and are hoping for a special girl in this litter to continue our breeding programme.

Both Callie and Sprout are heart tested by a specialist Cardiologist vet and so was Perfect Patch By Whippysnip (Sprout's father) Heidi, Dicky (Callie's parents were also all heart tested clear, So most of the pups 3 generation pedigree contains heart tested clear dogs. We generally have our girls heart tested every 18 months to two years, Both Heidi and Dicky are now in their retirement homes so we have no way of insisting on any further heart tests for either of them.. Although in general Whippets are one of the healthiest pedigree breeds, heart testing is very important and we signed up to the UK Whippet Clubs Heart Testing scheme back in 2018 when we bred our first litter. Sprout also has a current clear result on his eye examination certificate for PRA.

We usually let any potential new owners know the litter has arrived, and what we have in the way of girls and boys and colours etc, we will include photos of mum and the litter as a whole but won't include individual photos until the pups are around 10 days old as this is when Mum is settled enough to allow the pups out of her sight for a few moments to allow us to photograph them individually.

We then update you weekly with photos of the litter and individual photos and update you on their development. If you prefer you are welcome to initially reserve a pup from photos without obligation at this point as we don't allow visits until around 4 weeks of age, this is because until weaning begins, the mothers instinct to protect her pups is very strong and anyone she doesn't know will often be met with aggression and she becomes very stressed when her pups are not with her. So you can imagine if we have potential owners handling her pups before 4 weeks, how upset she would be. However by four weeks we will have started the weaning process as it usually begins around 3 weeks and lasts until around 6 weeks before the pups are no longer feeding at all from Mum and it is this process that helps prepare mum for the pups eventually leaving home, and therefore over the next four weeks she becomes less and less involved with the pups as they themselves become more

independent, We are always lead by Mum with this process and everything is on her terms.

The visit is a chance for you to meet us, the pups, Mum, and any female relatives of the pups (as since August 2024, we no longer have male whippets here due to my health issues and needing to keep the overall number of dogs we own to minimum) as well as giving you the opportunity to ask the many questions you have and for us to explain what we do as breeders and the processes we follow to enable us to raise happy healthy pups who are of sound true to type, temperament and confirmation from fully health tested parents. It is at this visit when you would make your final choice as to whether you want to proceed with having a pup from us and make your decision about which pup you want to reserve (obviously sometimes we already have pups who are reserved so the choice may be limited and sometimes its limited by the number of each sex in the litter, but we would advise you of that as each pup gets reserved). We never take a deposit at the visit as we like to give people the chance to go home and digest what we have talked about and ensure that we are the right breeders for them and that they are sure about everything before committing to a non refundable deposit which is equal to one third the price of a pup.

We charge £1500 for our pups regardless of sex, markings or colour all have breeding restrictions placed upon them - these can be lifted at a later date but ensures any owner wanting to breed comes back to me for help and support with breeding their dog to help protect what I and others before me have worked so hard to achieve and also helps protect the breed that I love so much. Also breeding is hard work and not something which should be taken on without careful consideration to everything involved as while I absolutely love what I do, and the emotional rewards I get from it can not be matched but when it goes wrong it is devastating and affects the whole family and it takes a lot to pick yourself back up and carry on. We take calculated risks every time we breed and I am not against anyone breeding if thats truly what they want to do, but it needs to be something you go into with your eyes wide open to what can go wrong.

After the visit we continue with the updates and photos we are on hand for you to ask anything you need to, to help you prepare for your new arrival. Each pup leaves us between 8-10 weeks of age having followed our careful socialisation plan, worming plan, been microchipped at 6 weeks of age and then vet checked and will have receive their first vaccination, Each of the pups leave us with a comprehensive puppy pack contacting

useful items for your pup and a 3kg bag of purina pro plan puppy food, as well as a initial free supply of Butternut Box (used as a topper food) and of course the all important information folder containing all of your pups information from KC paperwork, to contract of sale and everything in between. We also give you a copy of my comprehensive 200 page plus Whippet puppy raising handbook at your visit to allow you to prepare for your new family member.

This litter of pups would be ready to leave us from (depending on their birth date) around the 8th - 10th of April 2026 when they will be 8 weeks old. This is very much a from date and can leave us any time after they turn 8 weeks. However in our experience any time between 8 and 10 weeks of age is the ideal time for them to settle into their new family home and adjust to their new routine and surroundings easily with the minimum amount of stress.

I trust all of the above makes sense, please feel free to ask questions as that's what we are here for and we give 24/7 support to our new owners from the time your pup is pre-booked for the rest of your pups life should you need it. If you could let me know your experience of dog ownership in the past and your life and family commitments as this helps me know how best to advise you.

I very much look forward to perhaps helping you with your new family member.
